Project update

Snowtown Wind Farm 1

Snowtown 1 Wind Farm generated **325 GWh** of clean energy over the last 12 months (end Oct 2024).

In April, you may have also seen some extra people on site as Tilt Renewables and the Suzlon Energy Australia team completed an environmental compliance audit. This is an important activity to make sure we continue to meet our environmental obligations.

Royal Flying Doctors Service Outback Car Trek

Tilt Renewables and Snowtown 2 Wind Farm were pleased to support the 2024 RFDS Outback Car Trek by sponsoring Team Cobber. This great initiative provides funding to the Royal Flying Doctors Service, helping their medical teams support rural communities.

Team Cobber raised an outstanding \$175,000 for the RFDS. The eight drivers on the team drove from Bendigo, Victoria all the way to the Gold Coast, Queensland. The team are already planning for their next RFDS trek in 2025.

Snowtown Planting Day

Tilt Renewables partnered with the Snowtown Community Management Committee (SCMC) to purchase native seedling. s for restoring Snowtown's native grasslands, revegetation of the walking corridor between Snowtown and Bute, and providing a sensory garden for the local retirement home. In July our staff took part in a volunteer day with the Snowtown Community Management Committee where they planted 450 native shrubs and trees. The highlight for the day was learning about the rich history of the local landscape as the SCMC members shared stories of growing up on Gaurna / Kaurna Country.
