Over the past year, Coopers Gap Wind Farm has been a powerhouse of clean energy, generating an impressive 1,280 GWh! That's enough to light up 198,000 households and keep 1,137,000 tonnes of CO2 out of our atmosphere.

If you've noticed some activity around the site, it's because our dedicated maintenance team has been hard at work. Their proactive efforts included replacing generators, gearboxes, transformers and blades, ensuring everything runs smoothly and efficiently.
