As we near the end of the year, we thought we'd take a look back at 12 months of generation. All 80 wind turbines continue to be operational, with a second year of servicing underway.

The Dundonnell Wind Farm is Tilt Renewables' and Victoria's largest operating wind farm, and this year saw a total generation of 1,069 GWh worth of renewable energy flowing into the grid. That's the equivalent of powering approximately 177,000 houses or removing 486,000 cars from the road.

# Community Fund - Round 2 recipients awarded

This year's recipient of \$15,000 worth of education funding has been awarded to Derrinallum Mobile Preschool to expand the current sandpit. The funds will also help them procure a shade sail and a steel wall with rainbow-coloured windows that will 'colour the sand'.

## **Project compliance**

Compliance activities continue for the Project. The first Post-Construction Noise Monitoring Report found that the Wind Farm is compliant with the noise limits set out in the Planning Permit. The second round of noise monitoring will commence in late 2022 with a second report to be prepared and placed on the Project website with the first report.

Implementation of the Brolga Compensation Plan is ongoing with the Year 0 and Year 1 Reports on the Project website. The Year 2 Report has been submitted to the Department of Environment Land Water and Planning (DELWP) and we are pleased to report that brolgas have been sighted using the rehabilitated wetlands.

The Bat and Avifauna Management Plan, Year 1 Report is available on the Project website, with the Year 2 Report to be submitted to DELWP in early 2023. Year 3 monitoring activities commenced in November 2022.
