Weekly Construction Update - #13 Dundonnell Wind Farm

The Tilt Renewables team is underway with constructing the \$560 million Dundonnell Wind Farm located approximately 23km north-east of Mortlake, in the Western District of Victoria. AusNet Services are constructing 38km of 220kV transmission line and substation to which will connect the wind farm to the electricity network.

It has been an egg-celent week of construction activities on the Wind Farm as the first six kilometres of Woorndoo-Streatham Road now sealed and the last two kilometres are ready to seal. The site compound surface is now complete and ready for the installation of temporary facilities. Excavation of pole foundations and formation of track 1 are continuing.

If you hop on down to the Quarry it's business as usual, with the crushing and screening of rock material as well as drill crews on site setting up for the stage 3 blast.

The Transmission Line worksite is chocablock with the first batch of transmission poles were delivered to site. Foundation works continued with excavation works commencing on five foundations and earthworks continued at the Blue Gums Substation.
