Weekly Construction Update - #5 Dundonnell Wind Farm

The Tilt Renewables team has commenced construction of the \$560 million Dundonnell Wind Farm located approximately 23km north-east of Mortlake, in the Western District of Victoria. AusNet Services have mobilised to the Mortlake industrial area and have officially commenced work on the transmission line and substation works this week.

Work is continuing to progress well across the 5km of road upgrade on the southern section of Woorndoo-Streatham Road. Traffic control is in place and the speed limit temporarily reduced through works zones. Quarry works have also progressed with drilling equipment on site and on track to commence blasting in the coming weeks.

This week, work on the 38km of 220kV overhead **Transmission Line** and substation have officially begun, with site establishment works, surveying and pre-construction activities all commencing.
