## Weekly Construction Update - #7 Dundonnell Wind Farm

The Tilt Renewables team has commenced construction of the \$560 million Dundonnell Wind Farm located approximately 23km north-east of Mortlake, in the Western District of Victoria. AusNet Services have mobilised to the Mortlake industrial area and have commenced work on the 38km of 220kV transmission line and substation.

Construction activities on the **Wind Farm** are continuing to progress with 6km of road stripped and recompacted as part of the Woorndoo-Streatham Road upgrade. Site workers and locals had a blast this week, watching on as the first round of explosives were detonated inside the **Quarry** as part of the quarry works. Rubble from the quarry will be processed and used as source material for other wind farm construction works.

Pre-construction activities on the overhead **Transmission Line** and substation ramped up this week. Several deliveries of machinery, equipment and construction materials arrived to the site facilities located in the Mortlake industrial area.
