Weekly Construction Update - #8 Dundonnell Wind Farm

The Tilt Renewables team has commenced construction of the \$560 million Dundonnell Wind Farm located approximately 23km north-east of Mortlake, in the Western District of Victoria. AusNet Services have mobilised to the Mortlake industrial area and have commenced work on the 38km of 220kV transmission line and substation.

Wind Farm construction activities are continuing with 7km of 8km of road section stripped and recompacted as part of the Woorndoo-Streatham Road upgrade. Two drainage crews are now on-site installing pipes and culverts in road and driveway crossings. Over at the **Quarry**, construction crews have been absolutely crushing it this week, with crushing, screening and material exporting processes now in full swing.

Next week will see the start of the Mortlake-Ararat Rd and Woorndoo-Dundonnell Rd intersection upgrade. Traffic control crews will be setting up and specialist equipment delivered. Please take care as speed limits will be temporarily reduced through work zones.

Construction works on the overhead **Transmission Line** and substation have ramped up this week with the continuation of clearing, earth works and the formation of new access tracks. Drill rigs are on-site enabling us to commence drilling and excavation works (see image 1).
